



KNOW THE DIFFERENCE: E-BIKE vs. E-MOTORCYCLE

E-BIKE (ELECTRIC BICYCLE)



- ✓ Operates with pedals and electric assist
- ✓ Top speed: - 20-28 MPH
- ✓ No license, registration, or insurance required
- ✓ Can use bike lanes and trails
- ✓ Must be at least 15 years old to operate a Class 3 e-bike
- ✓ Must have a motor of not more than 750w.

E-MOTORCYCLE (ELECTRIC MOTORCYCLE)



- ✗ No pedals – throttle only
- ✗ Much higher speeds (30+ MPH)
- ✗ Requires driver's license, registration, and insurance
- ✗ Not allowed on bike trails or sidewalks
- ✗ Treated the same as gas-powered motorcycles under the law

WHY IT MATTERS: Misusing or misidentifying these vehicles can lead to citations, fines, or accidents. Ride smart. Ride legal.

- Safety gear is always a must!!
- Texas traffic laws apply to both vehicles.



Safety Reminder for Our Community

We kindly ask that you take a moment to review road safety rules with your children.

Please remind them to stay alert for traffic, avoid speeding, and refrain from performing tricks or unsafe maneuvers on roadways, especially when using motorized toys such as scooters, mini motorcycles, bikes, and similar ride-ons. These ride-ons are also prohibited on our community fields.

Road Tip: With the cleanup taking place on FM 1463, please be mindful of any debris on the roadway to help prevent damage to your vehicles.

Friendly Reminder: Homeowners are responsible for maintaining their wooden fencing in good condition. Please note that support posts installed outside the fence are not permitted and may require correction.

Please be mindful that any exterior modifications to your home require an ARC application to be submitted for approval.

Let's work together to keep Firethorne a beautiful, safe, and welcoming community for everyone!

Parking & Driving

-  Do not block sidewalks when parking in your driveway.
-  Use your garage or driveway when possible, to keep streets clear and safe.
-  Parking near mailboxes is for quick stops only while collecting mail no overnight parking.
-  Always yield to pedestrians in crosswalks and stay alert while driving.
-  For gated sections, ensure guests and delivery drivers have your access code to prevent unauthorized entries, accidents, and property damage.

Gated Section Reminder

Providing the correct access code helps:

-  Prevent unauthorized entry through exit gates
-  Reduce the risk of accidents and damage

Trash & Yard Care

-  Securely bag or bin all trash to prevent litter.
-  Trim low-hanging branches over sidewalks to keep pathways safe.
-  **July 17** Trash days: Wednesdays & Saturdays — do not put trash, debris, or recycling out prior to **6p** the night before.
- Store trash and recycling bins by **midnight** the day of pick up.

Amenities & Guests

-  Do not share key fobs with non-residents. Each household may bring up to 3 guests, and a homeowner must be present.
-  Tennis/Pickleball Courts: Courts 1 and 2 can now be reserved via the homeowner portal at home.inframark.com Other courts and sports fields remain first come, first served.
-  Review posted rules at amenities or visit our website to stay updated on all guidelines.

Wildlife & Neighborhood Etiquette

-  Do not feed wildlife. Birdseed or other food can attract unwanted animals and create nuisances for neighbors.
-  Political signage must be removed within 10 days following an election.
-  Dirt bikes are not permitted on sidewalks or trails.
-  Be mindful of noise, especially in the evenings, and considerate of neighbors.

Home & Community Living

-  Home businesses are not permitted if they are visible, noisy, or otherwise detectable.
-  If your fence was damaged during a storm, it should be repaired or replaced submit a modification application before replacing it.

Biking & Pedestrian Safety

-  Share sidewalks and yield to pedestrians when riding bikes or scooters.
-  Stay alert and distraction-free while driving or walking in the community.
