Fence Staining Amendment to the Modifications Guidelines for Firethorne

WHEREAS, the Firethorne Modifications Committee (the "Firethorne MC") of FIRETHORNE COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION, INC. (the "Association") wishes to adopt an amendment to the Modifications Guidelines for Firethorne (the "Modification Guidelines") in connection to the staining of fencing within Firethorne; and

WHEREAS, the Firethorne MC wishes to provide for uniformity of fence color within Firethorne; and


WHEREAS, the last paragraph of the section entitled "Fences" in the Modification Guidelines now provides as follows:

All wood fencing is to be left as its natural color to ensure that as it ages and weathers, all fencing will maintain a uniformed color and appearance. If fencing is to be sealed, it must be with a clear sealant. No colored stain or paint of any kind is acceptable or permitted.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED that the last paragraph of the section entitled "Fences" in the Modification Guidelines is amended to read as follows:

All wood fencing may be left in its natural color to ensure that as it ages and weathers, all fencing will maintain a uniformed color and appearance. No colored stain or paint of any kind is acceptable or permitted except that fencing may be stained with Wood Defender Coronado semi-transparent fence stain, or with a product which in the opinion of the Firethorne MC is an equivalent alternative stain. Prior to staining any fence, the Owner must present the Firethorne MC with an application that includes a sample of the proposed stain and must obtain the written approval of the Firethorne MC.

This is to certify that the foregoing Fence Staining Amendment to the Modifications Guidelines for Firethorne was duly adopted by the Firethorne MC, on SEPTEMBER 17TH, 2014.
